



- 01 Yuguang Bridge**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Sec. 3, Jiankang Rd. & Intersection of Guangzhou Rd.  
The connection between Tainan City and Yuguang Village. Looking out from both sides of the bridge, one will see harbor waterway slowly passing through it with lavish shrubbery waving along. It is a good place for a stroll.
- 02 Eternal Golden Castle**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Full fare \$50NT, half fare \$25NT No. 3, Guangzhou Rd.  
A former US destroyer arrived at Anping in the month of January, MinGuo year 67 and named as Deyang. Ship number 925 with 28 years of service and was decommissioned on April 1st, MinGuo year 94. The whole measures at 115 meters long, 12 meters wide, and weighs more than 2000 metric tons.
- 03 Deyang Ship Exhibition Hall**  
Opening / Admission/ Behind Eternal Golden Castle  
A former US destroyer arrived at Anping in the month of January, MinGuo year 67 and named as Deyang. Ship number 925 with 28 years of service and was decommissioned on April 1st, MinGuo year 94. The whole measures at 115 meters long, 12 meters wide, and weighs more than 2000 metric tons.
- 04 Linmoniang Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
On Anyi Rd.  
The statue of Linmoniang measures about 18 meters high and was carved out of granite. The sunset and night views around the area have made it a new tourism spot, and the intersection point of sea and land has become the new landmark of Tainan City.
- 05 Harborside Historic Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
On Anyi Rd.  
Unites Jahanu Aboriginal Park and Linmoniang Park. It is a park drawn on the harborside view and history. The park was designed to unite scenery and culture together, and is now a high-quality cultural, artistic, and educational recreation area.
- 06 Jahanu Aboriginal Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Intersection of Pingfeng Rd. and Anyi Rd.  
The Jahanu Aboriginal Park is located in the north of Anyi Rd. It is a park drawn on the harborside view and history. The park was designed to unite scenery and culture together, and is now a high-quality cultural, artistic, and educational recreation area.
- 07 Anping District Administration Center**  
Opening / 08:00-17:30  
Admission/ Free  
No. 316 Yunging Rd.  
The center covers District Office, Office of Affairs of Household Registration, Health Clinic, library, and Police Bureau etc. The area occupies 1.6 hectares, with an atrium square measured more than 2000 Ping (equivalent to about 72,000 sq. ft.), which provides people convenient services among different government organizations.
- 08 Sword Lion Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Intersection of Anbei Rd. and Yunhe Rd.  
The park refers to Anping old city. Words like "Pingan" (safety) and "Anping" were carved on both inner and outer city gates, wishing to bring pingan (safety) for tourists who come to Anping.
- 09 Canal Museum**  
Opening / 10:00-21:00 (closes on Monday)  
Admission/ Free  
No. 15-97, Anping Rd.  
Anping Customs of Tainan Canal, also the important checkpoint to inbound and outbound ships through Anping Harbor. It is now fully restored to its original appearance.
- 10 Underwater Scenic Trail**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Under Anyi Bridge  
The first underwater scenic trail in Taiwan, of which equipped with 7 pieces of clear acrylic windows. The whole trail is 68 meters long, 5 meters wide, and 2.5 meters tall, and one can observe fish through the clear acrylic windows. It is an emerging scenic spot.
- 11 Recreation Harbor**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Intersection of Gubao St. and Yunhe Rd.  
Records the layout mapped out for a live fish direct market, cooked food area, restaurants, seashore outdoor cafe, and observation area where one can enjoy magnificent Anping Harbor view.
- 12 Anping Harbor Trail**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
North shore of Anping Harbor  
The whole trail is 3.6 kilometers in length, which brings a great stretching visual effect and special lighting variations. Every stop one makes will feel like different experiences.
- 13 Oyster Shell ash Cement Museum**  
Opening / 09:00-12:00 / 13:30-17:00 (closes on Monday)  
Admission/ Free  
No. 1-110, Anbei Rd.  
Designated historic site by the City, the only Oyster Shell ash Cement Museum left. Inside the museum there are Culture Exhibition Hall, Oyster Display Square and a Central Square. It is a small museum with abundant information.
- 14 Wei's single-armed Old House**  
Opening / Private house, outside only  
Admission/ Free  
No. 6, Aly. 16, Ln. 121, Anbei Rd.  
Designated historic site by the City, an ancestral house formerly owned by a government official in Qin Dynasty, it is the best example of how a single-armed house was built in the old days.

- 15 Haishan Hostel**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Free  
No. 3, Ln. 52, Xiaozhong St.  
Grade 3 historic site, built by Fujian soldiers from China during Qin Dynasty, it is the only pavilion left of its kind, which existed to witness the reigns of government during Qin Dynasty.
- 16 Indigenous Culture Exhibition Hall**  
Opening / 10:00-12:00 / 14:00-16:00  
Admission/ Free  
No. 64, Guanyin St.  
(opens all day on Sat. and Sun. and closes on Monday)  
Grade one historic site, also called Erikshuan Artillery Fort, was the first modernized western fort in Taiwan. It was used as the protection of Anping Sea to fight against the invasion of Japanese troops during Madanshe Incident.
- 17 Guanyin (Goddess of Mercy) Temple**  
Opening / 05:00-22:00  
Admission/ Free  
No. 33, Guanyin St.  
The divisional deity temple in Anping in 1626, with Guanyin (Goddess of Mercy) as the main god worshipped by countless disciples.
- 18 Yanping street Old Well**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
No. 3, Ln. 148, Yanping St.  
The statue of Linmoniang measures about 18 meters high and was carved out of granite. The sunset and night views around the area have made it a new tourism spot, and the intersection point of sea and land has become the new landmark of Tainan City.
- 19 Anping Tourist Information Center**  
Opening / 10:00-12:00 / 14:00-18:00 (closes on Monday)  
Admission/ Free  
No. 790, Anping Rd.  
Provides information for recreational activities, free bicycle rental service, and a resting area.
- 20 Anping Old Fort**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Full fare \$50NT, half fare \$25NT No. 82, Guosheng Rd.  
(Ticket purchased can also be used for Fort Zeelandia Museum).  
Jahanu refers to "Phoenician City" in Jiao dialect, with the colorful aboriginal totems, stone-slated pavilion, and a distinctive pavilion "Kuba", the park is full of original humanities characteristic everywhere.
- 21 Kaitai Mazu Temple**  
Opening / 07:00-22:00  
Admission/ Free  
No. 33, Guosheng Rd.  
The center covers District Office, Office of Affairs of Household Registration, Health Clinic, library, and Police Bureau etc. The area occupies 1.6 hectares, with an atrium square measured more than 2000 Ping (equivalent to about 72,000 sq. ft.), which provides people convenient services among different government organizations.
- 22 Fort Zeelandia Museum**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Full fare \$50NT, half fare \$25NT No. 82, Guosheng Rd.  
(Ticket purchased can also be used for Anping Old Fort).  
The former Tax Affairs Pavilion, it is now remodeled as a modern commercial activity center where visitors can enjoy the advanced technology to experience the 17th century Zeelandia life.
- 23 Utrecht Fort (Spoon Mountain)**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Next to Anping Artillery Fort  
With a landscape like a spoon, it is nicknamed "Spoon Mountain". It was the first cemetery in Anping and also an important battlefield in history.
- 24 Twelve Army soldier Tomb**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Next to Anping Artillery Fort  
Built in memory of the first batch of soldiers who died during the war. Site in 1938, it is now 73 in age.
- 25 Lu's residence**  
Opening / Private house, outside only  
Admission/ Free  
No. 802, Anping Rd.  
Has won the Best Construction and Design Award in MinGuo year 98, it is a great indulgence to stroll around the harbor and to enjoy ocean view.
- 26 Wangjishi western-style multi-storied Building**  
Opening / Private house, outside only  
Admission/ Free  
No. 2, Ln. 35, Guosheng Rd.  
The building was built during the reigns of Japanese government and became rich. Then he built this western-style multi-storied building in MinGuo year 26, which was the most lavish and the tallest building at that time. The building is still kept in a very good condition.
- 27 Former Julius Mannich & Co.**  
Opening / 10:00-22:00  
Admission/ Free  
No. 3, Ln. 233, Anbei Rd.  
Designated historic site by the City, the only Oyster Shell ash Cement Museum left. Inside the museum there are Culture Exhibition Hall, Oyster Display Square and a Central Square. It is a small museum with abundant information.
- 28 Juijiouyng's former residence**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Free  
Next to Former Talt & Co. on Gubao St.  
Juijiouyng was born in 1898, worked as the director of Salt Bureau for the Ministry of Finance and was also a famous calligraphy artist. The residence was originally his dormitory, now open to public after years of restoration.

- 29 Former Talt & Co.**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Full fare \$50NT, half fare \$25NT No. 108, Gubao St.  
(Ticket purchased can also be used for Anping Treehouse).  
Grade 3 historic site, built by Fujian soldiers from China during Qin Dynasty, it is the only pavilion left of its kind, which existed to witness the reigns of government during Qin Dynasty.
- 30 Anping Treehouse**  
Opening / 08:30-17:30  
Admission/ Full fare \$50NT, half fare \$25NT No. 108, Gubao St.  
(Ticket purchased can also be used for Former Talt & Co.).  
Formerly the warehouse of Taiwan Salt Co., attached to a banyan tree after abandonment now formed into a distinctive treehouse phenomenon.
- 31 Chianlong Seawall**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Ln. 850, Anping Rd.  
Built in 1778 by Taiwan Governor of prefecture Mr. Jiang, the seawall was the most important protection in preventing tidal waves. It is also a live history now to witness the reigns of Chianlong government during Qin Dynasty.
- 32 Historic Waterscape Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
West wing of Former Julius Mannich & Co.  
A design incorporated with water, wooden trail, and windmill etc. It is a place where people can sit down and have a chat with friends while enjoy a beautiful Anping sunset.
- 33 Yanshen White beach Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
No. 196, Gubao St.  
Provides information for recreational activities, free bicycle rental service, and a resting area.
- 34 Waterscape Bridge**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
At the ending point of Anping Rd.  
The bridge plays an important role in connecting the activities in old Anping City area and the water activities along the seashore. Tourists are able to stroll along the bridge to enjoy nice harbor views.
- 35 Hubing water & bird Ecology Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
East wing of Sihcao Bridge  
A multi-purpose recreation park that combines water ecology and historic waterway and harbor view. Not only mapped out with abundant Mangrove ecology, but also bikeways and bird observation platform etc.
- 36 Pets' Sports Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
East wing of Sihcao Bridge  
With a landscape like a spoon, it is nicknamed "Spoon Mountain". It was the first cemetery in Anping and also an important battlefield in history.
- 37 Anping Tourism Fish Market**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Anping Harbor Wharf  
Records the layout mapped out for a live fish direct market, cooked food area, restaurants, seashore outdoor cafe, and observation area where one can enjoy magnificent Anping Harbor view.
- 38 Live fish Storage & Transportation Center**  
Opening / Private house, outside only  
Admission/ Free  
No. 55, Shingping 1st St.  
Designated historic site by the City, one of the most important old Taiwan, will also be the important hub for mid-sized and large-sized fish breeding in the future.
- 39 Anping Historic Lighthouse**  
Opening / Outside only  
Admission/ Free  
North beach of Anping Harbor  
The whole trail is 3.6 kilometers in length, which brings a great stretching visual effect and special lighting variations. Every stop one makes will feel like different experiences.
- 40 Chiaotou Park**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
South point of Sihcao Bridge  
Mr. Wang contracted the logistic business in the Salt Union during the reigns of Japanese government and became rich. Then he built this western-style multi-storied building in MinGuo year 26, which was the most lavish and the tallest building at that time. The building is still kept in a very good condition.
- 41 Sunset Observation Platform**  
Opening / Not limited  
Admission/ Free  
Across from Anping Historic Lighthouse  
An upside-down triangle was designed in order to keep the windbreak forest on both sides. Together with the dim lighting effect, Anping Historic Lighthouse, seashore, white sand, and windbreak forest, this area is full of romantic ambience.
