

**Good day, Speaker Chiu, Deputy Speaker Lin, and fellow councilors.**

**My team and I came here today to deliver a policy address at the Sixth Regular Meeting of the Fourth Session. I sincerely thank all the councilors for your continued support and encouragement, which has enabled steady progress in Tainan's municipal development.**

**When Typhoon Danas and heavy rains struck, Tainan City immediately activated its emergency response mechanism, coordinating central ministries, the military, civil organizations, and university youth volunteers. Upholding the spirit of "united as one, walking with the people," we devoted our full efforts to post-disaster recovery and reconstruction to restore residents' daily life as soon as possible.**

**To accelerate the recovery of livelihoods and industries, my team and I established 11 Joint Service Centers and launched a Post-Disaster Repair Matching Platform. Following the principles of "fair, swift, and simple," we disbursed over NT\$1.2 billion in disaster relief funds, assisted with home repairs and reconstruction, intensified waste removal and disinfection, and restored public**

**facilities and residential environments in an orderly manner.**

**In response to the newly revised Act Governing the Allocation of Government Revenues and Expenditures, Tainan continues prudent financial management while steadily promoting municipal governance. We are actively submitting a second amendment to the central government, proposing that the allocation of centrally funded tax revenues be tailored to county/city characteristics. We suggest inclusion of metrics such as output from the Southern Taiwan Science Park, demographic structure, and land area to realize balanced regional development.**

**Regarding the achievements of the Tainan City Government from the period of March 16, 2025, to August 15, 2025, a written report has been submitted to the council. Please refer to it at your own discretion. The following is a concise oral report on the achievements of the city government in the past few months:**

### **I. Flood Resilience and Preparedness for a Robust Homeland**

**To strengthen our city's flood resilience, we have commissioned the Anzhong Pumping Station, upgraded pump units at Qingkunshen, Jiangjun, Mashagou, Nanxing, Xinying, and**

**Xinglongsi stations, and completed Phase I of the Yanshui Drainage Improvement Project. Planning is underway for the Anding drainage system. The central government has approved subsidy funding of NT\$1.19 billion for the restoration of the lagoon and sandbar at Qigu. Through the strategy of “reducing inundation area, duration, and frequency,” we are systematically promoting regional hydraulic infrastructure to enhance overall flood control capacity.**

**To foster a low-carbon, sustainable environment, the Rende Reclaimed Water Plant is now fully operational and has secured a stable supply of industrial water. The second phase of the Centralized Treatment Plant at Baweng Dairy Zone is in continued progress. In pursuit of our “charging stations everywhere” ambition, we plan to build 202 electric vehicle charging stations. We have also installed 615 YouBike 2.0 stations, cumulatively serving over 10 million users. YouBike has become a preferred transport option for both commuters and tourists.**

## **II. Livability for All Ages, Inclusive and Friendly**

**To support youth and secure stable housing, we are developing 11,188 social housing units. The first batch of residences in “Livable**

**Ren'ai” and “Livable Chenggong” have welcomed tenants; “Livable Xindu A” and “Livable Xiaodong” are entering leasing phases; and “Livable Pingshi” has broken ground. The sequential rollout of social housing offers housing stability as more citizens settle.**

**With the mission of encouraging families and nurturing children, we established Tainan Municipal Shalun International Senior High School, covering education from kindergarten through senior high—the first of its kind in Taiwan—to cultivate globally oriented talent. Five new public kindergartens have been opened. We invested NT\$1.32 billion to enhance school commute safety and developed 82 themed public playgrounds.**

**Focusing on care, nurture, and joyful living for the elderly, we are building 516 community activity centers to enhance local public services. The “Hedaoting” long-term care facility in Lioujia District and “Orange Youth” senior housing in Anping have both broken ground. In the South District, we are planning a new model senior care center integrating community participation, eldercare services, and cultural/educational activities. Moreover, Annan District Mental Health Center, the fifth in the city, has opened to**

**safeguard citizens' mental and physical health.**

**To promote sports development, Tainan hosted the U-12 World Cup and U15 Asia Youth Baseball Championship, bringing athletes from domestic and international arenas to our city and elevating our sports city brand. We initiated the Annan and Xinying District Community Sports Center ROT projects, and construction has begun on the Yongkang District Community Sports Center. These projects embody the vision of accessible sports for all.**

### **III. Efficient Road Network and Balanced Growth for All**

**To build an efficient transportation network, we completed the main connector roads on the south side of the Xinshi Industrial Park. Work has begun to widen Xipu Central Road and create a new link to Wuqiao Central Road. Reconstruction of Dapu Bridge in Dongshan and the opening of Xinwan Bridge in Yongkang enhance regional mobility and road safety. Parking capacity has been expanded: the Ting 4 Multi-level Parking Structure in Chengde Village, North District is operational; parking lots Guangting 11 and Guangting 9 in Annan District are open; and the public parking adjacent to social housing along the north side of Xiaodong Road is complete. These facilities help address residents'**

**parking needs.**

**In terms of public transportation, the Yongkang Transfer Station began trial operations in October, improving transfer functionality. Tainan also introduced the “799 Greater Tainan Bus + Tainan-Chiayi TRA Unlimited Ride” TPASS monthly fare plan, ushering in a new era of integrated bus and rail commuting in the Tainan–Chiayi corridor.**

**Pursuing equitable regional development, we launched the Tainan Technology Industry Zone and commenced the Xinghua Land Readjustment Project in Shanhua to foster industrial upgrading and enriched livability. To elevate municipal construction standards, Tainan won six awards in the 2025 Yuan Ye Awards and secured 30 recognitions in the 2025 Real Estate Excellence Awards. These achievements have affirmed the city’s strong competitiveness.**

#### **IV. Talent, Investment, and Industrial Innovation**

**We are creating new momentum for industrial development. In May this year, the Executive Yuan announced that the Smart Robotics Industrial Cluster will be located in Phase III of the Liouying Technology and Environment Industrial Park. We will**

**also partner with NSTC and ITRI's two major smart robotics centers in Shalun and Lioujia to jointly advance the central government's robotics industry program. This collaborative effort will build a complete value chain from R&D to mass production. At the same time, we are promoting the Smart Rainforest Industry Development Plan to galvanize the deployment of AI applications across sectors.**

**Continuing to deepen our investment promotion strategy and attract quality businesses, we have attracted a total of 1,845 investment projects and created over 62,000 new jobs. Among these, 87 major projects (each exceeding NT\$200 million) are being overseen, with combined investments reaching NT\$309.8 billion. Recently, Eslite Spectrum Tainan and the Shin Kong Mitsukoshi Xiaobeimen outlet opened in succession. They have demonstrated Tainan's appeal as a place that is both livable and business-friendly.**

**We are further enhancing the value of agricultural production. The Ministry of Agriculture has established the Floral Industry Innovation Center in Houbi to form a new hub within the international floral technology cluster. We are actively introducing cold-chain technologies. This has enabled farmed tilapia's first**

**shipment to Singapore and Madou pomelos' export to Canada, and partnering with retail channels to promote Tainan's milkfish across stores in Taiwan. Additionally, my team and I participated in three major international food exhibitions in 2025. We catalyzed over NT\$920 million in business opportunities and brought the taste of Tainan to the world.**

## **V. A City of Culture & Artistic Flourishing**

**Rooted in deep cultural and historical traditions, our city designated monument West Market has been reborn with a modern visage, now transforming into a new highlight that integrates cultural experience, day-to-day functionality, and tourism appeal. To promote Taiwan's film and media industry, we signed an MOU with TAICCA to encourage both domestic and international productions to film in Tainan. Blending indigenous culture with modern health values, we hosted the Indigenous People's Day event "mihumisang – Healthy Movement Festival."**

**To elevate the city's visibility, we organized events such as the Yuguang Island Life Festival, 2025 Tainan Hot Air Balloon Party, the 16-Year-Old Youth Arts Festival, and the General Roar Summer Music Festival. To expand sustainable marine tourism, we**

**launched the Anping–Penghu Magong Tour Route to promote summer island-hopping in southern Taiwan. Tainan’s tourism strength continues to rise: lodging capacity is projected to exceed 16,000 units, and occupancy rates are expected to increase by nearly 10%. In the 2025 Michelin Guide, 61 establishments in Tainan were recognized, sharpening our image as a premier culinary and travel capital.**

### **Conclusion: Advancing Together Toward a Sustainable and Flourishing Tainan**

**Tainan is a city that harmonizes historical depth with forward-looking strength. The city government team, grounded in pragmatic action, will continue to reinforce infrastructure, promote smart industrial and economic applications, actualize social care and inclusion, and foster balanced regional development. Together, we aim to build a sustainable and flourishing Tainan.**
