


Boundaries of Tainan City

What Should I Do Before Disaster?

Preparation of Household Goods



Store a 3-day supply of food and water by the average consumption of the household, and remember to change the supplies regularly.







2 Home Surroundings Checkup

Secure furniture and make sure the doors and windows are intact and closed tightly.

Sealing the top

Fill up the upper space of furniture, so it won't slide around.



Arrangement of the interior

Put heavy objects on the lower shelves of closet, so it won't slide around.




Use shims or newspapers to let the furniture lean against the wall tightly, so it won't slide around.




Arrangement of peripheral item

Fasten heavy furniture to the wall tightly, so it won't fall onto the bed or block up the runway.

Surroundings and Family Disaster Preparedness Card



For the residents nearby seashores, be mindful of storm surges and seawater intrusion.

Residents in low-altitude coastal areas should be aware of any storm surges, and take precautions against sea intrusion.





Identify shelters in the neighborhood and the escape routes together with your family, and give your home a disaster checkup for safety and for help.

How to make sure the location of shelters?

- 1.Surf the websites of district offices.
- 2.Look at the disaster billboards or direction signs.
- Shelters divided by colors: green (earthquake), blue (flood), brown (mixed disaster).
- 4.Identify all information on disaster preparedness map (shelter location and phones).



Monitor Emergency Radio, News Radio, or Television News for Relevant Information.

You may download cellphone apps regarding disasters. (from Central Weather Bureau, Water Resources Agency, SWCB, etc.)



You may call Weather Info Hotline "166" or "167" via telephone or go directly to the website of Central Weather Bureau (http://www.cwb.gov.tw/V7/index.htm) to keep yourself updated with the latest information in preparation for various disasters (applicable to typhoon, flooding, earthquake).



You may go to Disaster Information Website of Water Resources Agency, Ministry of Economic Affairs (http://fhy.wra.gov.tw/PUB_WEB_2011/Default.aspx) to check the latest information regarding water, and sign up for the "Pro-active Civilian Flood Alarm System" for the latest flood information. (applicable to typhoon or flooding)



You may go to Mudslide Disaster Information Website (http://246.swcb.gov.tw/), constructed by the Soil and Water Conservation Bureau, Council of Agriculture, Executive Yuan (SWCB) for mudslide alarm and live images. (applicable to mudslide)





Message Board



Homepage: enter www.1991.tw





After entering the homepage, read the terms and conditions; if there are no issues, check the agreement box and enter the system



Enter the appointment number to proceed to the message boards



 Go to the bulletin board, enter the agreement phone number (password can be set according to individual needs).

Agreement Phone Number: If it is a local phone number, please include the area code. For example, for 02-2344/XXXX, please enter 022344/XXXXIf it is a mobile phone number, for example, 0901-216-XXX, please enter 0901216XXX.


Set Password: If you enter a password, the system will record the emergency contact person's email address you entered when looped in. Next time when using the same

person's email address you entered when logged in. Next time when using the same agreement phone number and password to log in, the system will automatically show the emergency contact person's email address.

- Select the bulletin board type you want to use (Bulletin board uses multimedia webpage; Accessible online message board uses traditional static webpage).
- Enter the captcha to click "send" to enter the bulletin board.
